GEN 097 Storm damage at Bell Street Orchard.

Reported in the Leicester Chronical and Leicestershire Mercury Saturday 12th October 1889 "Mondys Gale"

The storm of wind and rain on Monday did some damage to a number of trees in this locality, and one that was uprooted in Mr Forryans orchard narrowly escaped interrupting the telegraphic communication. It fell against the wires but fortunately did not break them. Most of the apples and other fruit which had not been gathered were blown off the trees.

\*\*\* He had a stall on Leicester market selling meat. It was opposite the cinema .His cart is in a Leicester museum. Owned land on Aylestone Lane just over railway bridge to the right going out of Wigston Magna.
