About the Pub

This estate pub was built by Banks's Brewery in December 1989, and has previously been named FORRYANS and POACHERS POCKET. There is a plain bar at the front; and a lounge at the back in "rustic" style decorated with old bricks and timbers.

Bank's Brewery ran a competition in the local paper asking for a new name and the reason for choosing the name. The competition was won by a local woman who remembered her childhood when she played on Forryan's farm where the new Inn was to be built.

At the opening of the Inn in 1989 Duncan Lucas had the honour of pulling the first pint of bitter and Mike Forryan the honour of drinking it.
